THE MOBILE CIRCUS 2008

The Palestinian Circus School is a Ramallah based NGO. Established in 2006, it teaches and performs circus art to engage, motivate and empower children and youth in Palestine. The school runs weekly circus clubs in Hebron, Ramallah and Jenin. It performed its first production 'Circus behind the Wall' many times in Palestine and abroad. The School is delighted to cooperate with the Danish Gøglerskolen for the Mobile Circus 2008.

"Gøglerskolen" (The School of Street Circus) in Århus, Denmark, started in 1989 as a social-, employment - and cultural project. Today it is a production school, financed by the Ministry of Education. The school welcomes young people between 15 and 25 without educational background. The students stay one year at the school and can study circus, street dance, costume design, public relation, carpenter, bar tender and business. "Gøglerskolen" comes for the first time to Palestine to start up a collaboration of exchange, training and performance with the Palestinian Circus School.
